SUD Medical Directors COVID-19 WebEx Thursday, October 29, 2020 | 1-2pm Executive Summary

Dr. Nicole Esposito, County Behavioral Health Services Department (BHS) Assistant Clinical Director, convenes DMC-ODS Medical Directors (MDs) on a bi-weekly basis via WebEx to provide updates regarding the County's COVID-19 response efforts as well as to dialog on issues faced by MDs during the COVID-19 emergency. The group reconvened on Thursday, October 29th at 1pm.

County BHS provided an <u>update on the Behavioral Health Continuum of Care and Drug Medi-Cal</u>
<u>Organized Delivery System</u> to the Board of Supervisors on October 27, 2020. Highlights included datasupported success of OTP response to the pandemic and a 90% increase in buprenorphine encounters from FY 18-19 to FY 19-20.

The County's BHS QM Team provided clarification regarding the regulatory updates for fentanyl, oxycodone, Hep C, and HIV testing requirements, as well as the blanket exception letter, for OTPs.

County Public Health Services Medical Consultant Dr. Sayone Thihalolipavan shared the latest COVID-19 update on the recently approved Abbott BinaxNOW rapid antigen COVID test and its process for local requests from health facilities.
