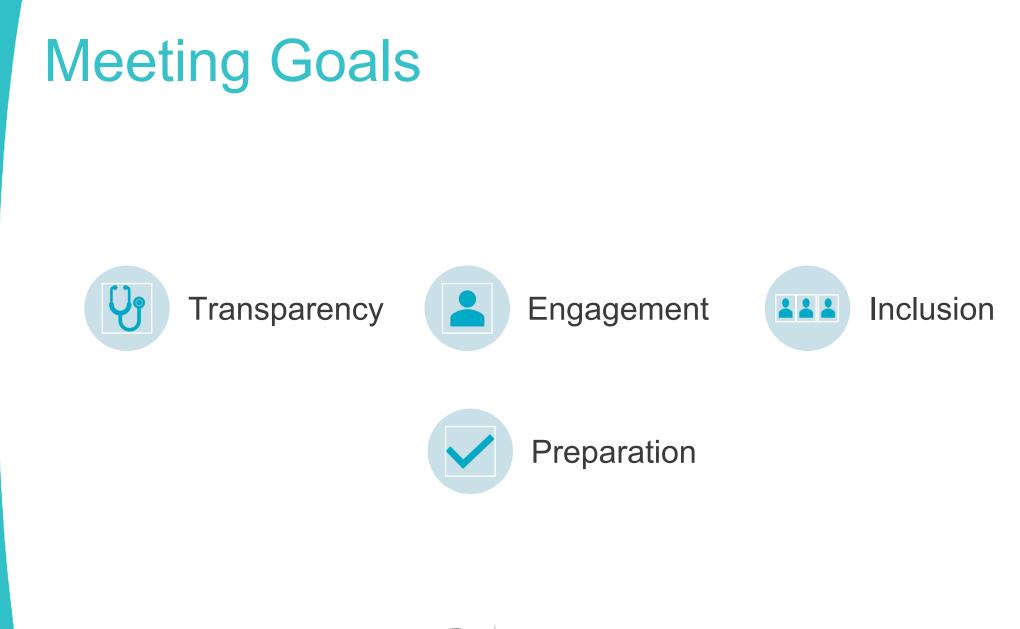

# Quick Cerner Recap

Highlights, Timeline, Engagement



### Highlights

#### What do I need to know now?

- CCBH will be replaced by Cerner Millennium (Cerner) as the Mental Health System of Care (SOC) electronic health record (EHR)
- Cerner is a completely new EHR, not an update to CCBH
- The goal is to optimize the EHR to best support client needs, SOC workflows, and regulatory requirements
- SOC Subject Matter Experts (SMEs) have been participating in the design process
- Last month, issues with functionality were identified that require resolution prior to go-live



#### SOC Engagement: Design & Build Why is SOC participation important?

#### Optimize decision making by securing early input to Cerner design and workflow

- Incorporate a variety of perspectives and expertise through diverse participation
- Ensure system meets the needs of end users
- Identify system challenges and recommendations to remediate

Upcoming Cerner Millennium Workshops: Monthly through November 2023



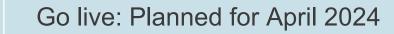
Continued system buildout: Ongoing through January 2024

Functionality & SOC Preparation



### SOC Impacts: Functionality

**Examples of Issues with System Functionality** 

- No automated capability to retrospectively bill via MMEF
- Diagnosis entry requires multiple steps
- Printing cannot occur outside of the County network
- Dual entry of services without a progress note



## **SOC Impacts: Training & Preparation**

#### What does this mean for training and go-live preparation?

We still need to be prepared:

- All sites will be responsible to ensure all Cerner users complete training prior to go live
- All sites will need to prepare for go-live, including downtime procedures
- BHS may require information from the SOC

### **SOC Actions**

#### What should the SOC do now to prepare?

- Communicate with your staff to raise awareness about the magnitude of change they can expect with a new EHR
- Begin to identify site champions at your facility
- Maintain awareness about project status to prepare in advance for go-live.



### **Next Steps**

#### What are the next steps for issue resolution?

- Continue to work with Cerner to find solutions versus workarounds
- Explore contingency plans in the event issues cannot be resolved
- Assess realistic go-live timelines
- Keep the SOC informed
