Outpatient services provided while a client resides in a lockout setting shall be documented with the following:

- 1. Appropriate Service Code for service provided (see case management exception below)*
- 2. Place of Service = lockout setting (This stops services from claiming)

<u>All</u> outpatient services provided, including Case Management, while a client resides in the above lockout settings are non-reimbursable as these facilities are considered complete lockouts.

Exception: Certified Peer Support Services (BH Prev Educ Svc Group and Self-Help/Peer Svcs Individual) are billable in Psychiatric Hospital and Residential Settings.

Outpatient services provided on the day of admission or the day of discharge from the above listed facilities are reimbursable as long as the *Place of Service* is **not the lockout location.

<u>Most</u> outpatient services provided while a client resides in the above lockout settings are non-reimbursable. Certified Peer Support Services (BH Prev Educ Svc Group and Self-Help/Peer Svcs Individual) are billable in Psychiatric Hospital and Residential Settings.

*Case Management/ICC services continue to claim to Medi-Cal, for the above listed lockout settings, regardless of *Place of Service selected*.

It is important to know when to use a billable SC50/SC82 versus a non- billable SC800.

- Case Management/ICC for discharge planning = billable SC50/SC82
- All other Case Management = non-billable SC800
- **Case Management/ICC for discharge planning is allowed 30 days prior to discharge date. If discharge is delayed, case management is not claimable until a new discharge date is set. Once the new discharge date is identified, case management for discharge planning may then resume, up to a maximum of 3 nonconsecutive periods, per stay.
